Staff Development and Reading Achievement Plans: No longer a seperate requirement from the School Improvement Plan.

State of the School Address: DIBELS composite scores for the beginning and middle of year presented and discussed. Attendance average of 95% on any given day. 13 chronic absentees, 20 no absence/no tardies, 59 no absence. Need to allocate \$2000 software and \$3000 STEM. DIBELS suggested for software, teaching materials for STEM. Currently, six tutors three days per week for half an hour each class.

Teacher Input: Math and Reading, Fluency, Behavioral Aspect, Basics, and Quality over Volume.

Principal Input: Reading Proficiency, Keep a STEM goal, Math (possibly a Staff Development of \$7500 for Comprehensive Math Instruction), MTSS.

Parent Input: Read 180, Staff Buyout for Homework Helper/Learning Lunch/Student
Advocate or similar intervention for struggling students to aid proficiency
goals, Scatter Group Training for the most effective use of Tier 2
instruction to aid proficiency goals.
