




If the District calls a late start, there will be NO Before School Program.



If the District calls for snow day, there will be NO Before or After School Program.



- All students must wear a mask (masks will not be provided).
- Temperatures will be taken on all students that come into the *morning* program. Students temperature must be below 99.5.
- Students will be taken to wash their hands and then they are delivered to their designated location.
- No more than 25 kids should be in any given area.
- Snacks will be delivered to the rooms by the runner.
- Rooms will be sanitized BEFORE and AFTER the program.
- A runner will answer the door in the afternoons and deliver the children to their parents (parents will not be allowed in the schools). Ring the doorbell (disinfected after every ring).
- If children start to show signs of sickness during the program the child is to be isolated and a parent called immediately for immediate pickup! We will call ALL authorized pick up contacts. If no one answers we will call the students guardians one more time, if no one answers we will call DCFS.
- Students and staff are asked to stay home from school if they have any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:



- Students should also stay home from school if they are experiencing other illness symptoms such as severe or long-lasting abdominal pain, rash with fever, strep throat, head lice before first treatment or any other illness that prevents a student from participating comfortably in school activities.
- Sunset Elementary Before and After School Program will follow all of Davis School Districts COVID-19 quarantine procedures.
- Mask break will be given when safety allows. If you do not want your student to have a mask break, please let us know.

### Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

#### Attendance Policy

Per grant requirements ALL students in both Before and After School must have 50% attendance. If your student reaches below 75% attendance, you will receive a letter stating your student may be endanger of losing their spot in the program.

#### After School Only

For the safety of your student we ask parents to notify the After-School Program if their youth will not be attending the program. Your student will not be allowed to make a phone call to ask if they can go home with a friend or anyone else. If the student has attended the school day and has not arrived at the program, staff will attempt to notify a parent or emergency contact. If no one can be reached and the child is not located local law enforcement will be called. A parent or guardian can reach the director by phone at (801) 410-3902. You can send your student with a written note or send a text message to the above number. \*There will be a \$5.00 finders fee if the student is late (more than five minutes) or absent without prior notice. This fee MUST be paid before your student(s) can attend the program again.





#### **Emergency and Disaster Preparedness**

- Evacuation site: If there is an emergency or disaster which requires us to leave our site, we will evacuate to 338 W 1800 N. parking lot (this is the yellow- white church on 1800 N.). If that site does not work out, our back up evacuation site is Sunset Jr. High.
- Monthly Fire Drills
- Quarterly Disaster Drills

#### **Behavioral Expectations**

- We use a card system to give the children a visual reminder about their behavior.
- Green indicates the child did or has done something exceptional and we feel they should be rewarded.
- Yellow indicates there are some concerns and the child needs to correct his/her behavior.
- Red indicates it is a serious problem. This must be cleared through the director.
- If the child receives a yellow or red card, you will receive the card during sign in/out. Parents must sign and return before the child returns to the program. If a child receives three yellow cards in one month (from date of first yellow card to date of last yellow card) he/she will automatically be moved to a red card. <u>One red card receives a full day suspension from the program.</u> Three (3) red cards will result in a full week of suspension (from date of first red card to date of last red card) and a meeting with the director and the parent. If more red cards are received a meeting with the parent, director and the principal will be arranged and possible suspension from the program. In the event of extreme misbehavior a child may be suspended from the program even if the child did not receive numerous red cards before (Safe School Policies). This typically will be a 5-day suspension.

# Homework Policy

- Students are required to work on homework for 30 minutes during program hours. Each staff member will assist students with their homework daily.
- If students do not complete their daily homework during that time, it will be sent home and become the parent's responsibility to help their student complete it. PLEASE check with your student every night to ensure they have completed their homework!



### UPON SIGNING OUT A STUDENT, EACH STUDENT MUST BE SIGNED OUT CHECK OUT PROCEDURE IDENTIFICATION WILL NEED TO BE OF THE PROGRAM! PROVIDED IF THEY ARE UNKNOWN. **ONLY** PARENTS OR PERSONS WITH PLEASE READ THE MONTHLY THIS IS FOR YOUR STUDENT'S SAFETY! CALENDAR!

WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE YOUTH FROM THE PROGRAM. IN **EMERGENCY SITUATIONS, THE** PARENTS MAY GIVE VERBAL AUTHORIZATION TO THE PROGRAM STAFF. AGAIN THIS PERSON MUST HAVE ID.
