Definition of Title I

- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind
- Title I status is allocated to schools based on the percentage of students receiving free and reduced lunch
- Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a school wide Title I program





Schoowide Program Defined

- The school uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school
- Title I funds are used to serve all children in order to raise academic achievement
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting academic performance targets





To be a Schoolwide Program...

- The school must have a free/reduced lunch count of at least 40%
- The school must collect and analyze data that affects student achievement
- The school must develop a comprehensive site plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan

Parent's Right to Know

- Title I schools are required to notify parents if their child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified



Right to Request Meetings

- Upon request of parents, the school must provide opportunities for regular meetings for parents to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of their children
- The school must respond to any such suggestions as soon as reasonably possible.
