SNAP/Safe Routes: Plan was reviewed and approved by Council and received the "OK" from the District, giving reason to believe the State will approve as well. Statement 2.1.10 concerning the bus loop was questioned. Parents have previously been asked not to use the bus loop, however it is happening more often. Following a parent complaint, the school will be putting cones down between the speed bump and crosswalk within the bus loop in hopes that will improve driver awareness of pedestrians.

Idle Free Policy: An Idle Free School Zone policy was proposed and approved. Research shows that school pick-up areas are a particular hotbed for vehicle pollutants. Pledges will be sent home asking parents to turn their vehicles off while waiting in the area around the school with the goal of improving air quality for students. The Council also discussed getting Idle Free signs to post around the school and possibly some small incentive for drivers that turn their vehicles off.

Digital Citizenship: Members confirmed that they received an email with a training video for community council requirements on digital citizenship. The FTC Heads Up booklets were sent home to parents. Coupled with the contract that parents sign for the safe use of technology, this meets the council's responsibilities to parents. A NetSmart assembly has been approved which will meet the council's training responsibilities to students.

Followup: In January, teachers will attend a training on identifying and addressing behavioral issues. Purchasing books for every teacher was previously proposed. The new idea is that some of the ideas be presented at faculty meetings while teachers that want to read the book have access to copies. Tier Support Intervention on the District web page was also presented as a good tool for teachers.

Dec. 5th from 8-9 am is the Title 1 audit. Council members have been invited, two have agreed to attend.
